

JEFF GIULIETTI, MPT, ATC, OCS, CSCS, COMT, FAAOMPT

He has been recognized internationally as a Fellow of the American Academy of Orthopaedic Manual Therapy (FAAOMPT) as having advanced competencies in clinical, analytical, and hands-on skills in the treatment of musculoskeletal (orthopaedic) disorders. He has expertise in differential diagnosis, primary care screening, pharmacology, radiology and imaging, manual therapy, therapeutic interventions, health care management, prevention and wellness, health promotion, histology, and pathology. He was in the first 500 PT's to be made a Fellow in the United States of America. Currently there are less than 1% of Physical Therapists in the USA who have received this title.

He has clinical experience of 30 years, dating back to 1988 in the professions of Athletic Training and Physical Therapy. In addition to his formal university training he has attended over 150 post-graduate courses (over 2000 contact hours) encompassing a wide variety of areas (see post-graduate education). During his Masters curriculum he was fortunate to have studied under *Jim Porterfield, PT, ATC* whose reputation for functional anatomy of the lumbar spine had national repute. Prior to this he interned under *Steven Roy, MD* (who held sports medicine international repute at the time) at the *Sports Injury Clinic* prior to its close in 1992, also contributing to the commitment to always being on the cutting edge of Diagnosis and Rehabilitation.

He has served as Certified Athletic Trainer (ATC) at the high school and university levels, as Physical Therapist (PT) in Hospital based Acute, Neurological, and Rehab units, and orthopedic settings, and more recently as ATC/PT at the *OLYMPIC* level in 2000, 2008, 2012 and 2016. In recent years he has been Team Captain of Sports Medicine services for all PT & ATC's for the USATF Olympic Trials (2012) in addition to the National Championships (2011) both held at historic Hayward Field here in Eugene.

Jeff is a Board Certified Orthopedic Clinical Specialist (OCS) through the APTA Board of Specialties, is a Certified Strength and Conditioning Specialist (CSCS) through the National Strengthening and Conditioning Association (NSCA). He is a Certified Orthopedic Manual and Manipulative Therapist (COMT) through the North American Institute of Orthopedic Manual Therapy (NAIOMT) and has been recognized internationally as a Fellow of the American Academy of Orthopaedic Manual Therapy (FAAOMPT) as having advanced competencies in clinical, analytical, and hands-on skills in the treatment of musculoskeletal (orthopaedic) disorders. He is a TMJ Specialist trained by world renowned Mariano Rocabado, DPT of Chili, Santiago, and was asked (2010) by the APTA to serve as an TMJ Subject Matter Expert for the published work: ***APTA 3rd Edition Current Concepts of Orthopedic Physical Therapy (2012)***. He is an Advanced Credentialed Clinical Instructor through the APTA (ACCI-APTA), Certified Sports Performance Coach for USA Weightlifting (USAW-SPC) and Certified Instructor for Aquatic Athletic Performance with the AQx Sports aquatic shoe. He is also a Herdman trained Vestibular Therapist, specializing in balance/vertigo/dizziness.

Jeff enjoys treating a wide variety of challenging patients, of which he has expertise in all musculoskeletal dysfunction (hand/wrist, foot/ankle, knee, scoliosis, hip/pelvis, lumbar, thorax, cervical shoulder, elbow, and TMJ disorders). His expertise extends to vestibular rehabilitation, neurological rehabilitation, headaches and oral facial pain, chronic pain, and Complex Regional Pain (formerly known as Reflex Sympathetic Dystrophy Syndrome (RSDS)). He is former Sports Medicine Faculty at Oregon State University and currently lectures on Proprioception, Manual Therapy, Advanced TMJ Diagnostic and Treatment, and many other areas of rehabilitation.

His background in motor control & motor learning has allowed him to apply this to both spine and extremity, combining this with movement awareness training, and advancing motor skills.
