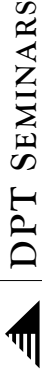

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This lecture/lab course is designed for primary contact physical therapists to advance their knowledge of orthopedic radiology and clinical interpretation of selected pathology that may assist them in making appropriate clinical decisions for medical referral, consultation, or treatment intervention leading to excellent clinical outcomes. This course will also present a brief review of general principles of orthopedic radiology and diagnostic imaging evaluations of normal versus pathologic bone and soft tissue structures. The main intent of this course is to provide the primary contact physical therapist with a high level of competence in the use of evidence based musculoskeletal imaging procedures and protocols that will assist their clinical decisions or treatment interventions in a direct access healthcare delivery system, as well as communication with other healthcare providers to facilitate safe, effective, and efficient patient management within the context of a collaborative multidisciplinary practice paradigm.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of this course, participants will be able to:

- Briefly describe the general principles of orthopedic radiology (ie, plain film, CT scan, MRI).
- Discuss the diagnostic imaging evaluations of normal versus pathologic bone and soft tissue structures.
- Describe the diagnostic process using appropriate imaging studies for differential diagnosis.
- Provide evidence for the use of specific imaging modalities for management of selected pathology.
- Order appropriate imaging studies based on patient history and physical exam, or treatment response.
- Make appropriate clinical decisions for medical referral, consultation, or treatment intervention based on interpretation of imaging studies.
- Competently discuss imaging findings with other healthcare professionals.

He is a health and wellness specialist, and is the founder and director of Dolphin Health and Education, a wellness and lifestyle center. He specializes in the management of spinal, shoulder, and hip dysfunctions. He is currently in private practice at **Dolphin Health and Education** in Medford, OR.

Edsen Donato, DPT, DSc, OCS, CHT, CSCS

Dr. Donato attended Loma Linda University and graduated with baccalaureate degrees in respiratory therapy and health science. Later, he completed his entry level master of physical therapy (MPT), and advanced level doctor of physical therapy (DPT) with a doctorate of science (DSc). His doctoral research *"Practice Analysis: Defining the Clinical Practice of Primary Contact Physical Therapy"* was published in the Journal of Orthopaedic & Sports Physical Therapy in 2004. He was the recipient of the 2005 Research Publication Award by the California Chapter, American Physical Therapy Association. He is an orthopedic manual physical therapist and is board certified in orthopedics (OCS), hand therapy (CHT), and strength and conditioning (CSCS). He is the founder of DPT Seminars. He has held adjunct faculty positions for the DPT programs at Northern University in Boston, and the University of Maryland in Baltimore. He is the director of Riverside Orthopedic Physical Therapy Residency Program. He is an APTA credentialed clinical instructor and is currently in private practice at **Riverside Physical Therapy** in Grants Pass, OR.
